**PW-04-2026 Solid Waste**

**ADDENDUM #3**

On March 12, 2026, the Township of North Huron posted Addendum # 3 to reflect updated information and clarify questions received pertaining to this tender.

**1. In Option One, updates to the following:**

- Remove wording *“and single stream recyclables”*
- Adjustment to the number of households: *2375, not 3590*
- Remove wording *“including commercial and industrial locations”*

**In Option Two, updates to the following:**

- Remove the wording *“and single stream recyclables”*
- Adjustment to the number of households: *2375 not 3590*
- Remove wording *“Single Family Dwellings, Semi-Detached, Duplex, Triplex, Apartment, Condominiums, including commercial and industrial locations.”*

**2. Q: “Can the municipality confirm the name and number of commercial and industrial locations included in collection?”**

*A: Not Applicable*

**3. Q: Could the municipality allow proponents to collect on all holidays, except Christmas day and New Years Day?**

*A: Yes, can collect on alternative holidays, subject to pre-approval by the Township of North Huron Director of Public Works & Facilities*

**4. Q: “Contractor must acknowledge the user pay garbage system. Proponents we would like to understand the adjustments with this system under cart collection?”**

*A: yes, proponents must acknowledge that current collection is based on user pay (garbage bag tags). Under cart collection, collection would remain user pay. It forms a part of the agreement.*

**6. Q: What material types they will collect in the front load containers listed?**

*A: solid waste*

7. **Can the municipality confirm that the municipality will confirm house count additions at the unit cost provided in the pricing schedule?**  
*A: There could be adjustments made to the number of homes, on a case-by-case basis.*
8. **Q: Schedule C does not have escalation for waste disposal, organics disposal and commercial bins. Can the municipality consider an escalator for these items?**  
*A. The consideration of escalator would be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and would be subject to a separate agreement if approved.*
9. **Q:” Schedule C does not include the weekly and bi-weekly options referenced in ‘Schedule A Services.’”:**  
*A: Costing should be determined on a monthly/yearly basis, not bi-weekly.*
10. **Q “Can the municipality provide metric tonnes currently collected for waste and estimated organic tonnes?**  
*A: 9 tonnes of solid waste and cannot estimate organics, as it’s not currently collected*
11. **Q “In addendum #2, the project name and number does not match the waste collection bid. Please confirm Addendum #2 PQ-03-2026 is invalid for this opportunity?”**  
*A: “Yes, Addendum #2 PW-02-2026 is invalid. It is for a different North Huron Tender Opportunity.*
12. **Q: “Given the extension date, please confirm the award date?”**  
*A: This opportunity will be presented at the April 20, 2026 Council Meeting. We anticipate it being awarded at that time.*

In addition, the following additional piece of information is included:

*Solid waste will be dumped on Tuesdays, at the North Huron Landfill, located at 86165 Currie Line, Wingham, ON N0G 2W0.*
